

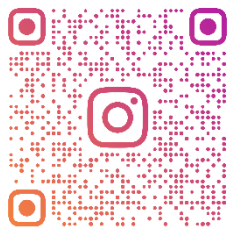

In January 2013, documentarian Laura Poitras was several years into making a film about abuses of national security in post-9/11 USA when she received encrypted emails from someone identified as 'CITIZENFOUR', who was ready to blow the whistle on the massive covert surveillance programmes run by the National Security Agency. Months later, she and reporter Glenn Greenwald flew to Hong Kong to meet 'CITIZENFOUR', who turned out to be Edward Snowden. This documentary of their various tense encounters is unique in the history of cinema: a 100% real-life thriller unfolding minute-by-minute.
